





THE FIVE-YEAR PLAN FOR KENYA

- ➤ Build ten houses, each of the 10 houses would be home to 20 orphaned children and a pair of missionary parents.
- ➤ Each house comfortably accommodates 22 people: 6 bedrooms 2 bathrooms; four children to each bedroom.
- \triangleright Two minibus that seats 22 28 is an immediate need to transport children to school, Church, etc.
- A chaplain family will be accommodated on site on duty 24/7 to cater to the needs of the children and to support of the missionary parenting couples.


